Pennsylvania State Grant Program

The Pennsylvania State Grant Program, administered by the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA), provides grants to eligible Pennsylvania residents who are in need of financial aid to attend a PHEAA-approved postsecondary institution. Recipients must be undergraduate students who have not received a first bachelor's degree and who enroll in a program of study that is at least two academic years in length. Those who applied in 2015-16 could receive up to \$4,340 as a full-time student at a Pennsylvania school. Students who attend non-profit schools located in other states may receive up to \$554 – or up to \$739 if they are veterans.* Students who enroll part time for at least six credits are eligible for one-half of the full-time award amount. State Grants are also available to students who enroll in summer sessions.

To be considered for a Pennsylvania State Grant, you must demonstrate financial need AND:

- Be a high school graduate as stipulated in the Pennsylvania State Grant law
- Attend a postsecondary school approved by PHEAA for Pennsylvania State Grant purposes
- Be enrolled at least half time (defined as at least six semester credits but less than 12 semester credits per semester, or the equivalent)
- Be enrolled in an approved program of study of at least two academic years in length
- Be enrolled in a program of study where at least 50 percent of the total credit or clock hours needed for completion of the program are earned through classroom instruction:
 - » The program itself must be structured to allow you to complete at least 50 percent of your credits or clock hours in the classroom.
 - » Your enrollment pattern must also consist of at least 50 percent classroom instruction per term (unless you have a medical disability approved under ADA specifications).
- Make satisfactory academic progress (as defined by PHEAA)
- Not have already earned a bachelor's degree or its equivalent
- Be a Pennsylvania resident, as stipulated in the Pennsylvania State Grant law
- Be of satisfactory character (for example, not be incarcerated)
- Not have received the maximum number of Pennsylvania State Grants permitted
- Not be in default or pending default on an educational loan. This also applies to any program where the award has been converted to a loan due to failure to meet all eligibility or service requirements and the loan is in a default status.
- File and complete the application process by the appropriate deadlines

* Effective with the 2015-16 Academic Year, only out-of-state, non-profit schools located in reciprocal states were approved for participation in the State Grant Program. A reciprocal state is one that permits its own state grant funds to be used by students attending schools in Pennsylvania. Prior to this change, out-of state, non-profit schools located in non-reciprocal states were also approved for State Grant Program participation. In 2015-16, reciprocal states included Delaware, the District of Columbia, Massachusetts, Ohio, Rhode Island, Vermont, and West Virginia. Students in all other states – with some limited exceptions – were ineligible. The limited exceptions included applicants attending institutions located in non-reciprocal states that offer unique programs of study not available at any other approved institution.

- h Maximum award held to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$1,500 if attending a Pennsylvania institution, to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$800 for all veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution, or to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$600 for all non-veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution.
- i Maximum award held to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$1,500 if attending a Pennsylvania institution, to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$800 for all veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution, or to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$600 for all non-veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution. Each State Grant is then reduced by approximately 8 percent and then the final term award is further reduced by approximately 4 percent at semester schools or by approximately 6 percent at quarter schools.
- j Maximum award held to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$1,500 if attending a Pennsylvania institution, to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$800 for all veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution, or to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$600 for all non-veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution located in a portable state, and to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$400 for all non-veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution located in a non-portable state.
- k Maximum award held to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$1,500 if attending a Pennsylvania institution, to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$800 for all veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution, to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$600 for all non-veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution located in a portable state, and to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$400 for all non-veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution located in a non-portable state. The final term award is then reduced by 10 percent at semester schools or by 15 percent at quarter schools.
- l Maximum award held to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$1,650 if attending a Pennsylvania institution, to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$800 for all veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution, to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$600 for all non-veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution located in a portable state, and to 80 percent of tuition and fees not to exceed \$400 for all non-veteran applicants attending an out-of-state institution located in a non-portable state.
