**INSTITUTION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- Must be a federal Title IV eligible institution located in Pennsylvania.
- Must complete and return the PA-TIP institution application by **December 31, 2016**.
- Must submit a copy of a current Eligibility and Certification Approval Report (ECAR) with the school application.
- Must complete and return a PHEAA Automated Clearing House (ACH) Authorization Agreement so that funds may be transmitted via Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). This form can be requested by email to **fmeftadmin@pheaa.org**. Once completed, please return by email to **fmeftadmin@pheaa.org** or by fax to **717.720.7656**.
- Must adhere to the Program Guidelines, which are available on the Document Library and on our website at **PHEAA.org/PA-TIP**.
- Must complete a Remote Access Agreement (RAA) if one is not on file; all school reports will be delivered through PHEAA's online system.

**PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- Must correspond to the PA Department of Education identified Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) codes (see Pages 4-5 for a full list of CIP codes or **PHEAA.org/PA-TIP**).
- Must be at least 10 weeks but less than two academic years in length and **cannot be eligible for a Pennsylvania State Grant**.
- Must not be completed through 100% distance education.
- Must be a federal Title IV eligible program of study.
