4. Of the above-referenced losses, indicate that amount which was or will be directly reimbursed through some form of insurance coverage.
5. PHEAA requires a complete copy of the 2010 U.S. Income Tax Return that you, if independent, (and your spouse, if married) or your parent(s), if dependent, filed with IRS, if such was not previously submitted.
