Re: Act 101 Student Income Reports

In past years, the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA) has provided Act 101 schools with two reports that identify Act 101 eligible students who currently meet the income level eligibility requirement, and students who surpass the requirement. The first report provides the school with Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) plus the untaxed income, the number of family members, dependent status, and year in college for each student. The second report provides the school with similar information on single independent students that do not exceed an income level of \$22,980, which is the required 200% below poverty level amount. The student's information may appear on multiple school reports because it is provided on the student's top three school choices as indicated on their FAFSA.

PHEAA will provide both reports on a weekly basis for all Act 101 schools beginning Monday, August 19, 2013. If a school would like to access these reports, the Act 101 director should contact their Financial Aid office and ask them to access the following report on PageCenter:

The Financial Aid Administrators who have access to PageCenter will need to sign in and retrieve the reports for you. Access is currently not available for Act 101 directors to directly retrieve this information.
